- Mailed applications must be received by the reservation center at least 10 days prior to the beginning of the desired camping period.
- Reservations must be made for a minimum of two nights and not more than fourteen nights. No specific campsite can be guaranteed.
- Reservations may be made by mail or telephone at number below.
- Campers are limited to two vehicles per site in addition to the camping unit.
- Camping fee is subject to change. If the fee is increased after application is confirmed, camper agrees to pay the difference at that time of arrival.
- If it is necessary to cancel or change a reservation, it may be done by mail or telephone with the reservation center.
- Confirmed reservations for multiple days will be held for 24 hours unless the park is notified of late arrival. If a camper fails to claim a reservation and fails to cancel the reservation, no refund will be given.
- If notice of cancellation for a campsite is received 48 hours before the reservation begins, all charges will be refunded. If notice of cancellation for the Recreation Hall is received 30 days before the reservation begins, all charges will be refunded.
- If notice of cancellation for a campsite is received on the day the reservation begins, the camper forfeits two nights camping fee. If notice of cancellation for the Recreation Hall is received less than 30 days before the reservation begins, the entire deposit fee will be forfeited.

Full payment must accompany the application, including the deposit fee if applicable.

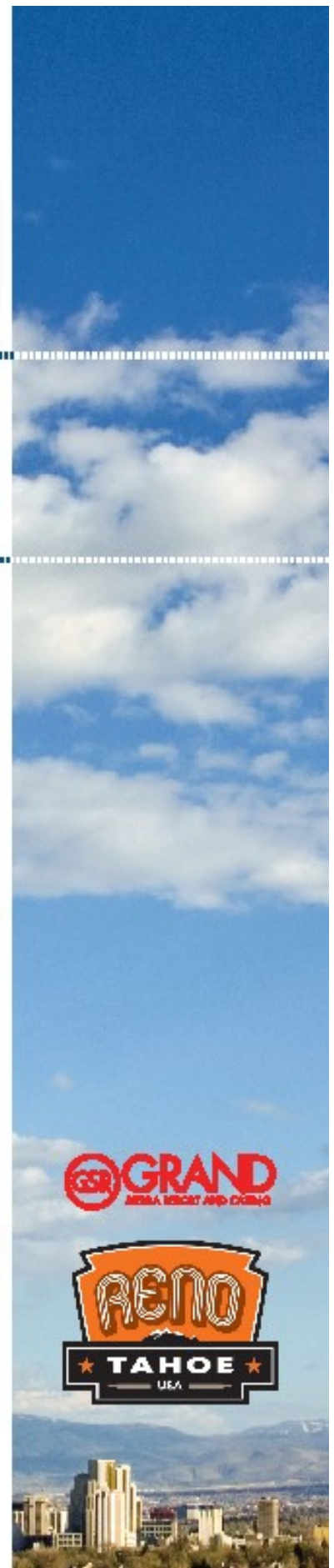
