

## Michigan District Rally Bike Show

As in past years, the Bike Show at the Michigan Rally will be done using the Wing Ding Bike Show Rules and Guidelines with one exception.

The rules state "Classes 1 thru 4 (GL1000, GL1100-1200) may be trailered to any Rally or Event in GWRRA" and "All other motorcycles will be ridden to the Rally or Event." Many of our members are traveling by 'toy haulers' but would still like to participate in the bike show. To accommodate everyone, and to help increase participation in the bike show, it was decided that any and all motorcycles at the rally will be eligible for entry into the bike show. All other rules will still apply.

Cleaning of bikes after they are staged for judging is not allowed. However, exceptions will be made for unusual conditions (extremely dusty areas, rain, etc.)
