Michigan Rider Course Registration is on the web. We hope for great things this year due to having a slow year or two. National Office has set the deadline of June 30, 2022 for Range Only classes with the stipulation that if your state is able to have both classroom and range, do so. So all our courses are set up to be the full classroom and range. We also plan on being able to fill your expectations as we have an additional ARC instructor this year, Edmund McDougale. His first two courses are to be with an experienced instructor and are part of his training, so be your usual friendly, participatory selves!

Classes will begin at 8:30 a.m. with an hour for lunch and range will end between 4 and 5 depending upon number of participants.

Neighboring states have set up their classes so check out their websites if you happen to live closer or have a free day in the hosting city area. Indiana Rider Education has two classes planned for May 21 in Monticello, and Ohio Rider Education has four classes planned May 7th and 8th in Canfield and May 21st and 22nd in Wilmington. Michigan Rider Education is proud that we host eight classes in four different locations, with less total chapters in the state compared to these neighboring two states.

I would like to thank all those who have held or have scheduled an MFA/CPR/AED class and to encourage others to get their class in our books.

Sometimes I feel like a broken record, but keeping your levels up is important; helping or saving a life of a loved one, friend or even stranger is priceless.

I'm glad to let you know that we are able to return to our previous class sizes. That means you need a minimum of 6 to hold a class. A class size is from 6 - 12 people. If you have 13 - 24 sign up, that requires two instructors and I need to know as soon as possible to be able to have both of them in attendance. No class over 24 is allowed. This is also why we ask that you choose three dates, so that we can coordinate the instructors. Should it not be possible for that to happen, we would need to split the class up. This is doable, as we want everyone to have the opportunity to take a class.

If you are reading this and would like to take a class, speak with your Chapter Director about scheduling one. Or if the Chapter as a whole does not yet need a class, you could get with me to see if another Chapter may be having a class that you could get in to.

I ask that Chapter Directors, please send in your request form listing three dates for a class, to Dennis Schulte. He will then send it to me and we can get the date and Instructor(s) for you. Classes are still only \$25 per person at this time.

### MOTORIST AWARENESS

I want to begin by welcoming Earl and Bobbi Gerard as the new Michigan District Assistant Motorist Awareness Coordinator. They have been very active in the Motorist Awareness program and have helped many people become more aware motorist. Welcome!

I would like to remind you that you can contact me anytime about presenting a Motorist Awareness program to your Chapter or other group you may be involved with or know of. It could be at a school, VFW, American Legion, church, or any other group of people who would like to become more aware motorist. Also, there are normally short video clips that you can present yourselves at a Gathering. At this time, however, they are not available. I will let you know as soon as they come back online. I can present one of two different tailgating programs. Just let me know if you would like them.

Chapters that have a Motorist Awareness person, I would love it if you would contact me with what you have going on in your Chapter, or with ideas for future events. Chapters that do not have a Motorist Awareness person, you may want to consider having someone volunteer for this. It's not an Officer position, but they would be a part of the Chapter Team. At this time there are no monthly reports to do. I do like to hear from you, but it's not required. It's all about helping ALL drivers be more aware of their surroundings, which helps them watch out for US! It's not really about Rider Education, it's about Driver Education, and that includes all of us. Chapter Directors, please consider this!

We're all happy thinking about spring and riding again. Well, we believe that thinking in particular about the wonderful month of May is the best.

The entire month of May is known as Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month across the nation. This is a time that we really try to get the word out even more to the general population about Looking Twice and Saving a Life--or two. Of being aware that we're out there! We're on traditional 2 wheels, trikes and can-ams. We want and NEED to be seen!

Saturday, May 14th is known as Motorist Awareness Day. This touches on the same safety, yet expands it some to encourage motorist to be completely aware of their surroundings while driving, even more so since we'll be out on the roads. To help teach the children riding in the vehicle to watch out for motorcycles.

This day would be a great day to plan an event. It's not too late. It could be at a park, a shopping mall, a store, downtown on

the sidewalk, or many other places. Make sure and get permission soon. There are trifold brochures that can be gotten from GWRRA National for FREE. Even shipped free. You could download and make copies of the special coloring 'book' from the GWRRA National site found under the Motorist Awareness Program, and get some crayons to give to the kids. Again, getting them to start watching out for us while they're young is a great way to start them off to be a safe driver.

Another plus to having this event is that copying the coloring page and getting some crayons and putting 3 or 4 in a baggie, is your only real expense. If you want to hand out small candies, (such as rolls of Smarties with an attached tag that reads something like "Be a Smartie--watch out for Motorcycles!"), that wouldn't add much to the budget.

You can even expand on this and use it as a membership drive.

Again, you can get new member brochures from GWRRA National for FREE, again with free shipping.

So don't wait until the last minute to start planning. If your Chapter has a Motorist Awareness person, talk to them about getting this in the planning. If not, you could talk with your Chapter Director about planning an event. May 14th will be here before you know it.

We'd like to thank all of the Chapter Motorist Awareness persons who help educate those around them. Those who write articles for their newsletters. Those who help hand out tri-folds, magnets or yard signs to adults and coloring pages to kids. You do make a difference and we appreciate you.

never come back. If someone tries to contact a Chapter Director and the information has not been updated, they will call or email the wrong director, who might never reply.


