Proud of GWRRA Michigan,

It is not only great to be able to have classroom and course Rider Courses again, but to see so many helpful faces out there is always the best way to start off the year's courses. Although working with these places remain difficult due to parking lots not being blocked off, staff changes, building changes, etc., you show up ready to hold a tape measure, listen and respond, bring up discussion topics, and work through them with us.

U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) reports that motorcyclist deaths accounted for 14% of the total highway fatalities in 2020. Per vehicle mile traveled, motorcyclists were about 28 times more likely than passenger vehicle occupants to die in a motor vehicle crash and were 4 times more likely to be injured. We are not trying to scare you with these statistics.

There are risks to everything we do and even what we don't do. Statistics on motorcyclist fatalities and their causes do give us some reasons. 34% of all motorcycle riders involved in fatal crashes in 2020 were speeding. Motorcycle riders 25 to 29 years old involved in fatal crashes had the highest speeding involvement at 45%.

Motorcycle riders involved in crashes had a 27% higher percentage of alcohol impairment than any other type of motor vehicle driver. 41% of the 2,158 motorcycle riders who died in single-vehicle crashes in 2020 were alcohol impaired.

Do what you can; love what you do. Protect you and yours. Drive safely, drive defensively. Take rider safety courses.

COUPLE OF THE YEAR / INDIVIDUAL OF THE YEAR

Many Chapters announced their Chapter Couple and Individual of the Year at their Christmas party, or in January to begin the year.

Others have announced in other months since, and some are still to be announced. I trust that you'll continue reading as I discuss possible concerns about when announcements are made.

For all of our Chapter Directors, I thought it might be a good time to review some basics before announcing a Couple or Individual.

*The Couple must consist of one male and one female. *Both male and female must hold Individual or Family Membership in GWRRA.

*Membership must be valid through the conclusion of the term of the Chapter Couple or Individual of the Year position they are being announced for.

*The Couple or Individual must have completed at least oneyear membership in GWRRA prior to being named Chapter Couple or Individual of the Year.

**A Couple or Individual may not be selected as a Chapter Couple or Individual of the Year in consecutive years. If a Chapter does not have a new Couple or Individual of the Year to replace the current Couple or Individual, that Couple or Individual may continue to serve as the Chapter Couple or Individual for a second term. However, they may only participate in the District Selection in the first year!

***Speaking of the District Selection, only the CURRENT Chapter Couple or Individual may go through the Selection process at Wingless.

And they need to have been the Chapter Couple or Individual for at least 90 days. Please remember this when you choose your announcement dates. Those announced in December or January could make the 90 days before Wingless, depending on the Wingless date in March. Plus, they would want to/need to, go through the process right away. If not, they would no longer be eligible the next year as they would no longer be current. Perhaps those announced mid year might be best as

would have time to enjoy being their Chapter ambassador and gain activities for their resume in case they do choose to go through the Selection process at Wingless. Something for some Chapters to consider that they might want to change.

The Chapter Director selects that deserving Couple or Individual, they DO NOT ASK them. Equate it to the Oscars or Grammys. They are not asked if they want the famed statue. They are simply honored to receive it for what they have done in the past, not what they will do in the future.

Movin' on...

Do you realize that the Wild West isn't that far off! We're planning to add a little sweetness to all of you, and asking for your help to do just that. Gayle and I have been discussing a way to help with the state funds to cover some of the expenses that the State pays to our new Couple and Individual. Similar to the things done to help with Rider Ed funds. It's just being honest that the funds are not what they used to be. So, we've talked, and we brought Dave in on this conversation, of course. Motorist Awareness Month may be technically over, but that in no way means we give up the 'fight' to educate drivers about learning how to drive without distractions, and even more importantly to educate drivers about how to watch out for all types of motorcycles and other vehicles on the road.

It's about educating them as home owners to not blow their grass into the road when mowing their lawns. It's about educating them about why a motorcycle may be moving back and forth within their lane going down the road. About why they pass the semi's so quickly and then slow back down to a safe speed. It's about educating them in the dangers of tailgating, and about the differences in the distance that it takes a bike and trike to stop versus a car.

It's about educating passengers in vehicles and children riding in the vehicles about how to help the driver watch out for motorcycles. It's about educating them to do their very best to not distract the driver.
