

We cannot start setting up dates until the colleges, universities, high schools, and county buildings set up their calendar for the coming year which won't be until after the first of the year. Congratulations to our latest Level IV Tour Masters in Michigan, Rick and Joy Hebner (10691 and 10692).

Also, the job summary for the Chapter Skills Enhancement Advisor (C-SEA) was handed out at the Fall Officers Meeting, Dennis read it out loud to everyone at the meeting, it was sent out to all the chapters for their newsletters, also placed in last month's Michigan newsletter, and an email went out from the DD approximately September 18th.

The Chapter Skills Enhancement Advisor is NOT an officer. There is no signing, no swearing in, and no patch. BUT, there is no sliding in or moving over to this position. The qualifications are very clear. The Chapter Director must appoint and we as MI DE's will accept an email stating that the CD has done so. We will then call the C-SEA candidate(s), and if things work out, a Confidentiality Agreement will be sent to the C-SEA candidate(s). They will sign and date and send it back to us; they will then hold the title of Chapter Skills Enhancement Advisor. The Chapter Ride Coordinator created by National Office two years ago IS an officer and as such, is under the District Ride Coordinator. There is no sliding in or moving over to that position either, especially since it is an officer's position and thus recognized by National Office. Brent and Sandy Blackburn as the District Ride Coordinator are who you need to contact. That officer position requires a completed and graded Rider Education Knowledge Level Evaluation. There will also be an Officer Appointment Worksheet and Memorandum of Understanding signed.
